Curriculum

We are using the Good and Beautiful Curriculum to implement our core subjects of Math, Science, Language / Reading, and History. Additional enrichment classes / clubs will be created based on teachers and parent's expertise. Some examples of these clubs and enrichment classes include PE, cooking / nutrition, art, book clubs, typing, and music theory. Additionally, field trips in nature and events that help to enhance the curriculum taught will be offered at least monthly.

Number of Students

Morning Star Academy currently has twenty-two 1st through 7th grade students enrolled.
